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In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the Board has requested to identify the venue for conducting the written examinations at 46 City / District centres on 28.06.2025 and 29.06.2025 for the recruitment of Sub-Inspector of Police -2025.

2) In the meantime the Government has issued orders in G.O.(Ms).No.410, Home (Police-III) Department, Dt:18.08.2025 for conducting the Common examination to all the candidates (Open & Police departmental) for the post of Sub-Inspector of Police.

3) Hence, the Board has proposed to conduct the Main Written Examination and Tamil Language Eligibility Test on 21.12.2025 for the recruitment of Sub-Inspector of Police -2025. The number of candidates allotted to centres is furnished in Annexure-I. The guidelines for identification of venues are enclosed along with model seating arrangement in Annexure -II & III.

**Annexure-IV**

**RECRUITMENT OF SUB-INSPECTORS OF POLICE (TALUK & AR) FOR THE YEAR 2025**  
**GUIDELINES FOR VENUE IDENTIFICATION**

**GENERAL GUIDELINES**

1. Officers in the rank of SPs/COPs should personally visit the venues before finalisation. TNUSRB will also be reviewing the selected venues besides a review by the Super Check Officers.
2. Venue should not be chosen mechanically based on past recruitments. Every venue should be assessed freshly based on the norms provided by TNUSRB.
3. TNUSRB will pay Rent @ Rs. 10/- per candidate to the educational institutions. The same may be informed to the concerned managements.

**GENERAL PROCEDURE FOR THE VENUE IDENTIFICATION**

1. **LIST OF INSTITUTIONS:** A complete list of educational institutions in the District/City headquarters must be obtained. This list should be the starting point for exercise of venue identification.
2. **SHORTLIST OF VENUES:** The venue identification committee should visit all the venues and shortlist suitable venues based on the norms given below. Capacity of each shortlisted venue must be scientifically calculated based on the norms given below.
3. **SUBMISSION OF VENUES INSPECTION REPORT AND FINALISATION:** The venue inspection team will submit its report to COP/SP who will finalise the venue and send to TNUSRB as final report on venues.

**NORMS FOR ASSESSMENT OF VENUES**

1. **ACCESSIBILITY:** Venue should be easily accessible to the candidates through normal public transport.
2. **ENTRY EXIT POINTS / PERIMETER:** Venue must have proper and strong perimeter/boundary wall with specific numbers of entry points so that proper access control can be maintained.
3. **BASIC NEEDS OF CANDIDATES:**
  - a. Each candidate must be provided with table and chair for writing the examination. No candidate will be made to sit on floor.

- b. **TOILETS AND WATER FACILITY:** Toilet and drinking water facilities for the candidates are absolutely necessary for all the candidates and must be ensured for women candidates.
- c. **CANTEEN FACILITY:** Providing paid canteen facility inside the venue by Police/ Private caterers /Institution canteen will facilitate the candidate to attend the afternoon examination.

**4. SEATING ARRANGEMENTS:**

- a. **SEATING UNIT:** Basic examination seating unit comprises of 20 candidates in  $5 \times 4$  or  $4 \times 5$  rows pattern. No other row pattern like  $2 \times 10$  or  $1 \times 20$  should be adopted under any circumstances. There are 4 series of question papers (A, B, C and D). These Series are provided so that no adjacent candidates have same question papers. Also check sufficient light and ventilation arrangements.
- b. **MINIMUM DISTANCE:** Minimum distance between any 2 candidates should be at least 4 feet in order to avoid copying or communications and following social distancing norms. Minimum distance between each unit is 5 feet.
- c. **ADJACENT UNITS IN ONE ROOM:** In case more than one unit are placed inside a single room or hall, care must be taken to ensure that candidates of same series do not land in adjacent seats. This can easily be ensured by following the seating arrangements enclosed in Annexure-IV.


- 5. POWER BACK UP:** Venue must have some sort of power back-up preferably or alternately external back-up (Generator) can be arranged.
- 6. PA SYSTEM OR TIME-BELL FOR TIME:** PA system facilitates announcements for both candidates and the invigilating staff. At least time bell system should be available.

**7. CCTV SYSTEM:**


- a. One CCTV camera should be installed in each class room and for bigger hall consisting of two or more units, minimum of 4 CCTV cameras should be installed.
- b. Availability of CCTV System in the common areas is desirable. However, basic CCTV system can be installed for covering the general areas and /or entry points.

**8. STRONG ROOM:** A strong room preferably Headmaster rooms in schools or principal room or any other closed room collections should be identified for temporarily storing trunk boxes having Question papers & OMR Answer sheet for Tamil Language Eligibility Test for Saturday Afternoon session.
