- 1.1. **PGT** (Physical Education): A Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in Physical Education and 50 percent in the aggregate. Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- 1.2. **PGT** (Chemistry): A Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in Chemistry and 50 percent in the aggregate. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education. Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- 1.3. <u>TGT Hindi:</u> A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in Hindi and 50 percent in the aggregate. Hindi as an elective subject at Degree level A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education. Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

- 1.5. <u>TGT Computers:</u> PGDCA/ MCA/ BE from any Govt recognised institution. Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- 1.6. <u>TGT HWT (Health Wellness):</u> Graduate Degree, with a minimum aggregate of 50 percent, from any University recognised by the Govt of India/UGC/AICTE.Diploma in Counselling from a Teacher recognised University or BA/BSc Psychology with Educational Psychology/Counselling Psychology from a recognised University or MA/MSc in Counselling Psychology or MA/MSc Psychology with Counselling Psychology as specialisation or MA/ MSc in Applied Psychology with Counselling Psychology from a recognised University. Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.7. **PRT (Primary Teacher):**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% mark and 2 year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) from a recognized board.

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B El Ed).

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2 year Diploma in Education (special education).

Graduation with at least 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B Ed) from any NCTE recognized institution along with six month Bridge Course in Elementary Education recognized by the NCTE.

Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.
