FEBRUARY - 2026

Applications are invited for the Computer on Office Automation (COA) course and the Government Technical Examinations (GTE) in Commerce Subjects (Typewriting, Shorthand, and Accountancy), to be conducted under a new, unified system from February 2026. This notification combines the processes for both COA and GTE in Computer-Based Examination (CBE) and Traditional Method of Examination (TME).

- All candidates are advised to carefully read and be fully aware of the information contained in Circular No. DOTE/194/2025-RO2 dated 10.03.2025, 18.04.2025, 26.04.2025, 23.06.2025, and subsequent circulars issued thereafter.

III. NEW REFORM PROCESS AND EXAMINATION MODE

This examination adopts a new one-time registration process and offers flexible examination modes:

A. Registration and Enrollment

1. **One-Time Registration:** Candidates must complete a single registration that includes all pre-qualifications for all subjects they intend to appear for.
2. **Enrollment Choice:**
 - Enrollment is permitted through an approved Institution or as a Private candidate for TME.
 - Enrollment for **COA, Computer-Based Typewriting, and Computer-Based Shorthand** subjects is permitted as direct enrollment only.
3. **Facilitation Centres:** Applications of all Candidates / Institutions will be mapped to Facilitation Centres in each district for Verification and Grievance Redressal (if any).
4. **Practice and Preparation:**
 - For CBE: Candidates must engage in mandatory practice through the online Learning Management System (LMS) provided by the DoTE for all CBE.
 - For TME: Candidates must have undergone 3 months of Training as on the date of Publication of this Notification either through Approved Commerce Institutions or by Self-Learning.
5. **Model Test:** A Model Test will be conducted for all Computer-Based Test (CBE) subjects. This does not apply to TME.

Note:

For CBE,

- If the candidate practices with their own PC, the Exam will be held in a separate soundproof room at their location during the CBE Remote window.
- If the candidate practices at an Institute, the Exam will be held in a soundproof cabin or room at the institute during the CBE Remote window.
- In the event of any deficiency in the required infrastructure on the part of the candidate, he/she may appear for the examination at the designated Computer-Based Examination (CBE) Centres during the notified CBE Examination Centre window.

IV. ELIGIBILITY AND FEES

A. Educational Qualifications

1. COA:

Pass in SSLC or Equivalent Exam is the essential qualification for appearing COA.

2. JUNIOR GRADE TYPEWRITING (ENGLISH & TAMIL):

Pass in Eighth Standard or equivalent Examination, can appear for Junior Grade.

3. SENIOR GRADE TYPEWRITING (ENGLISH & TAMIL):

Pass in the Junior Grade Typewriting Examination of the concerned subject can appear for the Senior Grade.

4. SHORTHAND JUNIOR (ENGLISH & TAMIL):

Pass in SSLC or Equivalent Exam is the essential qualification for appearing Junior Grade.

5. SHORTHAND ENGLISH INTERMEDIATE GRADE:

Pass in Shorthand Junior Grade of English is the essential qualification for appearing Intermediate Grade.

6. SHORTHAND SENIOR (ENGLISH):

Pass in Shorthand Intermediate Grade of English is the essential qualification for appearing Shorthand English Senior Grade.

7. SHORTHAND SENIOR (TAMIL):

Pass in Shorthand Junior Grade of Tamil is the essential qualification for appearing Shorthand Tamil Senior Grade.

8. HIGH SPEED TEST IN SHORTHAND & TYPEWRITING (ENGLISH & TAMIL):

Pass in the Senior Grade of the concerned subject is the essential qualification for appearing High Speed Grade.

9. ACCOUNTANCY JUNIOR GRADE:

Pass in SSLC or equivalent examination can appear for Accountancy Junior Grade.

10. ACCOUNTANCY SENIOR GRADE:

Pass in HSC conducted by the Government of Tamil Nadu, or Pass in SSLC and pass in Accountancy Junior Grade, is the essential qualification to appear for the Accountancy Senior Grade.

B. Examination Fees

Fees for the registration and examination must be paid online only. Amount once paid will not be refunded or adjusted for subsequent examinations.

V. INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES AND INSTITUTIONS

A. Before the Examination

1. Candidates must possess the required qualification on the date of this Notification.
2. **Do not send** the hard copy of the application to the DoTE.
3. **The Examination Process may be rescheduled with prior notice on the official website, depending on the number of candidates registering to maintain the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP).**
4. No Candidate will be permitted to appear for the Examination in more than one Grade in the same subject at the same session of Examination for GTE.
5. If the Candidate wants to appear for one or more subjects of any particular category of subjects, only one application must be used for GTE and a separate application for COA.
6. The Examination fee must be paid only using the payment link provided in the portal by the online payment gateway. Payment transaction details will be updated in the portal. Fees once paid will not be refunded or adjusted for subsequent examination.
7. The department is not responsible for online payment status pending cases occurring during the last hours of the online application closing date.
8. The following list of items should be uploaded to the online application portal.
 - SSLC passed candidates should upload the self-attested copy of the Certificate.
 - Bona fide Certificate with the photo (cross-signed by the school Principal), Full Name and Date of Birth for Students without SSLC Standard qualification.
 - The candidate should upload a self-attested copy of the pre-qualified Technical Examination Certificate.
 - Any Government-approved Identity proof bearing ID number, Photo, Name and Date of Birth (Aadhar Card, PAN Card, Driving Licence, Voter ID, School or College ID with Register No. etc.,) is mandatory to upload, which should match the filled data.
9. Applications submitted in other modes and the Online applications that do not fulfil the conditions will be summarily rejected without giving any notice.
10. The Examination Time-Table and Details of Examination Centre can be seen on the official website.
11. Candidates have to fill in the Subjects properly in the appropriate place in the online application. Once the admission is given, the submitted data cannot be changed later on.
12. The online application should be submitted on or before 12.01.2026 - 05.00 pm.
13. An application submitted and generated with a valid application number will be processed for the examination.
14. Online applications received on or before the prescribed date with a generated application number and with remittance alone will be accepted, provided all

requirements are fulfilled. It should be noted that under no circumstances, mere remittance of fees without the online application submission will not be considered.

15. Hall Tickets generated based on the data submitted in respective applications with reference to the unique application number will not be corrected at any cost.
16. Candidates with **mismatching data in the Hall Ticket in comparison with the submitted Original Identity Proof will not be permitted** to take up the examination.

For TME:

17. Approved Typewriting Institute Candidate must be divided into two batches for Pre-Junior, five equal batches for Junior, four equal batches for Senior and one batch for High speed. If it is noticed otherwise, the department will change the batches, and if the Institutes ask for any changes to the batch in the Examination Centre, it will not be considered.
18. DoTE will allot the batch for the private candidate for GTE through TME. If applied for only one subject, he/she shall be allotted the 5th batch only for junior grade and the 4th batch only for senior grade. If the private candidate applies for two Junior grade subjects, they can appear for one subject in the 5th batch and the other in the 4th batch only. Similarly, if the private candidate applies for two Senior grade subjects, they can appear for one in the 4th batch and the other in the 3rd batch only. If the private candidate applies for two subjects of different grades, they shall be allotted the 5th batch for junior grade and the 4th batch for senior grade.
19. Batch change will be permitted only for the examinations announced on or after the date of submission of the online application. Circular for the same will be published on the official website. As notified in the circular, for such batch changes, the candidate should approach the examination centre allotted two days before the commencement of the examination (Thursday or Friday, 10.00 am to 04.00 pm only).
20. For approved Commerce Institutions, in order to avoid corrections in applications, obtain the signature of the candidate in the preview copy and after careful verification, submit the application and obtain their signatures in the final application also.
21. Candidates appearing for the subjects for which the Institute is approved should be presented through the Institute, and their names will be included in the Nominal Roll. If any deviation is found either now or later date, actions will be initiated.
22. The Typewriting Machines should be arranged in the Examination Hall with the prior permission of the Chief Superintendent on 13.02.2026 from 4.00 PM to 5.00 PM for institution candidates and on 14.02.2026 from 6.15 PM to 6.45 PM for private candidates. All the typewriting machines must be taken out on 15.02.2026

after 4.30 pm. Without the permission of the Chief Superintendent, the Typewriting Machines should not be brought to the examination centres or taken out of the exam hall/center. The Examination Centre and the Examination Officials shall not be held responsible for the safety, loss, or damage of any belongings brought by the approved Institutions and/or the candidates.

B. During the Examination:

1. The candidate should bring the Hall Ticket, Original ID card (submitted during online application) to the examination hall.
2. If the candidate is unable to bring the same Original ID proof uploaded in the online application, a Xerox copy of any other ID proof listed in the online application should be submitted to the Chief Superintendent after showing the Original Copy of the same at the exam centre.
3. No Candidate will be permitted to appear for the Examination in more than one Grade in the same subject.
4. The applications of the candidates who do not fulfil the conditions stipulated in the application form will be rejected. If, by any chance, candidates who do not possess the requisite qualification or submitted false information in any case, get admitted and consequently appear for the examination, the results of the examination of such candidates will be cancelled. Similarly, if at any time, it is found that the certificate produced by the Candidate and sought admission is bogus or tampered with, the candidate concerned will be debarred permanently from appearing for the Government Technical Examination (both GTE and COA), besides the cancellation of the result in addition to any other punishment that may be decided by the Chairman, Board of Examinations.
5. Candidates should be aware of the different types of malpractices apart from the above, which are uploaded on the official website.
6. Sharing of personal belongings/stationery shall not be allowed.
7. The candidates have to go through the Instructions given in the Hall Ticket and adhere to them.

For TME:

8. Proprietors are allowed **20 minutes** in between two batches to arrange the machine, and candidates are allowed a practice session.
9. Proprietors must collect the practice papers/anything used for practice and leave the Exam Hall/Room and Corridor **10 minutes** before the commencement of the Examination (except the Mechanics authorised by the Chief Superintendent with a proper ID card).
10. It is the responsibility of the proprietors to arrange for adequate Mechanics to rectify the malfunctioning of the typewriting machines.

11. Apart from the Mechanics, expert Proprietors are allowed to act as a Mechanic with an identity card issued by the Chief Superintendent of the examination centre to attend to the issues in the Typewriters in the examination hall during the examination.
12. If any discrepancies are reported by the candidates for improper maintenance of typewriting machines, it will be viewed very seriously.
13. The candidate must ensure the working condition of their Typewriting machine.
14. The Candidate should write the Register Number and Name only in the FLY SLIP, and it should be filled up carefully as mentioned in the Hall Ticket.
