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- Flight Instructors shall do briefing /de-briefing of student pilots, this is to include the long brief, pre-flight brief, and post-flight brief etc. including using FOQA analysis
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- Maintain the student pilots flight reports on time and to process accordingly.
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- Assist CFI & Dy. CFI in monitoring and developing the highest possible personal qualities and discipline of the student pilots.
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- Always adhere to Standard Operating Procedures of the FTO.
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- Flight Instructors will conduct Flying Simulator Training as well as scheduled by Operations.
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They will keep them self-current with DGCA Regulations, revisions in TPM, revisions in SOPs and FOB.

- Ensure proper documentation is conducted pre and post flying/simulator exercises.

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- Ensure adherence to standardized training practices across the cohort

- Flying Instructors shall complete their eGCA tasks on time.
