

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR TGT (CONTRACTUAL)
AIR FORCE SCHOOL THANJAVUR

Mandatory Qualifications

(a) A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt. of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as under :-

(aa) TGT (Computer) : PGDCA/ MCA/ BE from any Govt recognised institution

(b) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(c) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(d) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation up to a maximum of five years.

(e) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(f) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(g) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except TGT Hindi, Sanskrit).

Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection)

(a) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(b) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(c) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PRT (CONTRACTUAL)
AIR FORCE SCHOOL THANJAVUR

Mandatory Qualifications

(a) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2 – year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) from a recognized board.

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B El Ed)

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Education (special education)

Or

Graduation with at least 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B Ed) from any NCTE recognized institution along with six-month Bridge Course in Elementary Education recognized by the NCTE.

(b) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(d) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation up to a maximum of five years.

(e) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(f) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(g) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection)

(a) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(b) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(c) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PRT GAMES TEACHER (CONTRACTUAL)
AIR FORCE SCHOOL THANJAVUR

Mandatory Qualifications

(a) Bachelor in Physical Education (B.P.Ed/BPE) from a recognized university.

Or

(b) Bachelor degree with Physical Education as an elective subject with 50% marks.

Or

(c) Bachelor 'sdegree with Physical Education as an elective subject with 45% marks and participation in National or State or Inter University in sports or games or athletics recognized by Association of Indian University or Indian Olympics Association.

Or

(d) Bachelor degree with 45% marks and participated in national or state or inter-university sports or games or athletics.

(e) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(f) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation up to a maximum of five years.

(g) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(h) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(j) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PRT SPECIAL EDUCATOR (CONTRACTUAL)
AIR FORCE SCHOOL THANJAVUR

Minimum Academic and Professional Qualifications
Pre School / Nursery / Play School

- (a) Xth Class passed and Certificate Programme in Early Childhood Special Education.
Or
- (b) XIIth passed and One year Diploma Programme in Early Childhood Special Education (DECSE-MR) / DECSE-VI
Or
- (c) XIIth passed and Diploma in Teaching Young Children (Deaf and Hard of Hearing)
Or
- (d) Xth Class passed and Certificate in Care Giving Programme
Or
- (d) Any other equivalent qualification approved by RCI

Minimum Academic and Professional Qualifications
Elementary (Primary / Upper Primary)

- (a) XIIth passed and two year D.Ed. Special Education in any of the category of disability.
Or
- (b) XIIth passed and One year Diploma in Special Education (DSE) in any of the category of disability.
Or
- (c) Diploma in Community Base Rehabilitation (DCBR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.
Or
- (d) Post Graduate Diploma in Community Based Rehabilitation (PGDCBR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with special Needs.
Or
- (e) Diploma in Multi Rehabilitation Worker (MRW) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with special needs.
Or
- (f) Junior Diploma in Teaching the Deaf
Or
- (g) Primary level Teacher Training course in Visual impairment
Or
- (h) Diploma in Vocational Rehabilitation – Mental Retardation (DVR-MR) / Diploma in Vocational Training and Employment – Mental Retardation (DVTE-MR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs
Or
- (j) Diploma in Hearing Language and Speech (DHLS) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR NTT (CONTRACTUAL)
AIR FORCE SCHOOL THANJAVUR

Mandatory Qualifications

- (a) Senior Secondary with Nursery Teachers Training diploma or diploma in Nursery/Montessori/Pre-Primary Teachers Training or Diploma in Elementary Education from a Govt recognised institution. While candidates with higher qualifications may apply, preference is to be given to candidates with diploma in Nursery/Montessori Training.
- (b) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (c) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation up to a maximum of five years.
- (d) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (e) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT/ PRT/ or three years as NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.
- (f) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection)

- (a) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- (b) Should be able to read/write/communicate in Hindi.
- (c) Experience in art, craft, cartoon, caricature, puppet making, music, dance etc.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR HELPERS (CONTRACTUAL)
AIR FORCE SCHOOL THANJAVUR

(a) Only the following categories of Helpers (erstwhile Multi-Tasking Staff) are to be employed as per the scale authorized as per Para 7(d), Chapter 4 of Edn Code 2020. Henceforth, only the following trade categories of Helpers are permitted:-

- (i) Ayah
- (ii) Peon
- (iii) Gardener
- (iv) Sweeper

(b) No educational qualifications are laid down. However, candidates should be selected keeping in view suitability for trade duties.

(c) Should be in the age group of 21 to 40 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(d) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation up to a maximum of five years.

(e) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(f) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years.

(g) BOO must satisfy itself about the genuineness of the date of birth of the candidates.
